Who are we?

The Centennial Fire District provides fire and medical services to the cities of Lino Lakes, Circle Pines, and Centerville. Nearly 30,000 residents count on us everyday! We respond to over 1000 calls for assistance each year.

Our firefighters are local residents who dedicate their time to become the communities highest trained emergency responders. Our firefighters participate in prevention efforts, respond to emergency and non-emergency incidents, train, teach, and spend time together after hours. We are a family oriented group who strives to be one of the best emergency response agencies in the area.

You see us in the news, read about us in the paper, and see our trucks go by all the time. You may have asked yourself, "how do I become a firefighter?"

We are looking for women and men to become part of our team. From fires, weather related emergencies, medicals, hazardous material incidents, water rescues, and more, we are prepared to respond anytime on any day.

Minimum requirements to apply:

1. You must be at least 18 years of age.
2. Must have the ability to read and comprehend written material.
3. Must possess the mental, physical and medical health to adequately perform the duties of a firefighter.
4. Must be able to obtain a valid Minnesota Class D drivers license and have a good driving record.
5. Must live within one of the three cities we provide service for. Those living closer to a fire station will be given higher points than those that do not.
6. Must have a clean criminal background.

Ideal Candidate:

We are looking for individuals with strong community service interest that can be part of our team for many years. We want positive people who enjoy working with others as a team and can maintain confidential information. You should be physically and mentally fit to handle "all weather" and "all-hazards" anytime of the day or hour. You want to learn and be challenged.

Training:

The fire district pays for all your training to include firefighter 1, firefighter 2, Emergency Medical Technician, Hazardous Materials, Water Rescue, Commercial Emergency Vehicle Operator, and more. You do not need any experience. We train you and provide you with proper safety equipment. Your commitment is to the community and the fire district.

Compensation:

After initial training, you will be paid an hourly rate for the time you spend at the fire district. Along with that, the CFD puts money away for your retirement. The CFD pays all workman's compensation insurance and some disability insurance as well. Your focus however, should not be the money. This is NOT a fulltime position. Focus on serving your community as one of the best.
